A 5% discount on annual tuition fees is offered if they are paid in full by 31<sup>st</sup> January of each year. There is also a sibling discount of 5% for the younger child or children.

The following additional levies are charged per term:

- A Capital Development Levy of R2,250.00
- A Consumable Levy, which covers all compulsory additional charges for items such as workbooks, the School Magazine, JEFA, plays, outings, and specific grade items as listed below:

Grade 0 apart from the items listed above, the levy also covers eye and hearing tests.

Grades 1- 3 the levy covers the programme music cost.

Levy per term: **Grade 0** R1,450.00, **Grade 1** R1,700.00, **Grade 2** R2,600.00 and **Grade 3** R2,750.00

Grades 4 – 6 the levy covers music theory, the compulsory school camp, study-skills and the life-skills workshops.

Levy per term: **Grade 4** R2,650.00, **Grade 5** R3,250.00, and **Grade 6** R3,550.00

Grade 7 the levy covers the music theory, study-skills, and life-skills programmes, and an annual entrepreneurship workshop. Levy per term: R2,550.00

Items **not** included in the levy which will added to the account as and when they arise:

- Birthday books;
- Items purchased from the PTA Swop Shop;
- Any other music programmes such as String Ensemble, Marimbas, Jazz Band etc., where only the girls who participate are charged (note: this excludes choir and orchestra);
- The optional Music Theory examination;
- Music books and repair of music instruments;
- DVDs ordered of school productions;
- Fundraiser tickets;
- Any optional tours, such as Music Tour and Hilton Arts Festival.

Any extra mural, music lesson or therapy sessions with a private service provider will continue as a private arrangement between yourself and the provider.

St Katharine's, together with two other independent schools, supports Salvazione School. There is a R100 voluntary donation added to each child's account every term which goes to our outreach school, Salvazione.
